Following the sad passing of Her Majesty The Queen, we are writing to you to let you know that there may be temporary changes to council services in your local area, including road closures, throughout the ceremonial period and up until the funeral.

Roads, parking and travel

Temporary road closures will be in place across areas of central Westminster. This will restrict traffic and impact public transport. Temporary parking suspensions and restrictions will be put in place in many areas in the City.

Please be aware you may be asked to move your vehicle or bicycle.

Streetworks

Streetworks will be carried out across areas in central Westminster. In some areas, work will be required overnight. Action will be taken to minimise disruptions and disturbance however we apologise for any inconvenience caused.

Recycling and rubbish

Recycling and rubbish collection services will operate as normal. However, on some days, services may be affected due to road closures or restrictions.
